- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 28.0024 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 28.0024. FILM SCREENING REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN STUDENTS.
- 8 (a) Each school district shall require 8th grade and 11th grade
- 9 students to attend a screening of the film America: Imagine the
- 10 World Without Her.
- 11 (b) On written request from a student's parent or person
- 12 standing in parental relation to the student, the school district
- 13 shall excuse the student from attending the screening.
- 14 (c) The commissioner shall adopt rules and procedures as
- 15 necessary to administer this section, including procedures to
- 16 ensure that the film designated under this section is distributed
- 17 to school districts and exhibited to students in a manner that does
- 18 <u>not violate copyright laws.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 20 school year.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
