- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 29.005, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 $\underline{\text{(a)}}$ The judge of a municipal court serves for a term of
- 8 office of two years unless the municipality provides for a longer
- 9 term pursuant to Article XI, Section 11, of the Texas Constitution.
- 10 <u>(b)</u> A municipal court judge who is not reappointed by the
- 11 91st day following the expiration of a term of office shall, absent
- 12 action by the appointing authority, continue to serve for another
- 13 term of office beginning on the date the previous term of office
- 14 expired.
- 15 (c) Judges who continue to serve under Subsection (b) may
- 16 continue to perform the duties of their offices without an
- 17 additional Oath or Affirmation required pursuant to Article XVI,
- 18 Section 1, of the Texas Constitution.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to
- 20 municipal court judges who are in office before, on, or after the
- 21 effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
