- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 44.281, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 44.281. DISPOSITION OF FINES AND COSTS WHEN
- 8 MISDEMEANOR AFFIRMED. In misdemeanor cases affirmed on appeal from
- 9 a municipal court, the fine imposed on appeal and the costs imposed
- 10 on appeal shall be collected from the defendant, and the fine of the
- 11 municipal court when collected shall be paid into the municipal
- 12 treasury.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 14 offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 15 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 16 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 17 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 18 this section, an offense is committed before the effective date of
- 19 this Act if any element of the offense occurs before the effective
- 20 date.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
