H.B. No. 4127

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the creation of the Foster Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Montgomery County; granting a limited power of eminent domain; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose assessments, fees, and taxes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Chapter 7926 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 7926. FOSTER MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF

MONTGOMERY COUNTY

SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec. 7926.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

(2) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

(3) "Director" means a board member.

(4) "District" means the Foster Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Montgomery County.

Sec. 7926.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

Sec. 7926.003. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTORS' ELECTION REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent

1 directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

2 Sec. 7926.004. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The
3 temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 7926.003
4 until each municipality in whose corporate limits the district is
5 located has consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of
6 the district and to the inclusion of land in the district.

7 Sec. 7926.005. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT. (a)
8 The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit.

9 (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of:

10 (1) a municipal utility district as provided by
11 general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and

12 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that
13 relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation,
14 or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or
15 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.

16 Sec. 7926.006. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
17 district is initially composed of the territory described by
18 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.

19 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
20 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
21 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
22 does not affect the district's:

23 (1) organization, existence, or validity;

24 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes
25 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
26 interest on a bond;

27 (3) right to impose a tax; or

1 (4) legality or operation.

2 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

3 Sec. 7926.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is
4 governed by a board of five elected directors.

5 (b) Except as provided by Section 7926.052, directors serve
6 staggered four-year terms.

7 Sec. 7926.052. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after
8 September 1, 2015, the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed
9 value of the real property in the district may submit a petition to
10 the commission requesting that the commission appoint as temporary
11 directors the five persons named in the petition. The commission
12 shall appoint as temporary directors the five persons named in the
13 petition.

14 (b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:

15 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under
16 Section 7926.003; or

17 (2) September 1, 2019.

18 (c) If permanent directors have not been elected under
19 Section 7926.003 and the terms of the temporary directors have
20 expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or
21 reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that
22 expire on the earlier of:

23 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under
24 Section 7926.003; or

25 (2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the
26 appointment or reappointment.

27 (d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a

1 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district
2 may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the
3 commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five
4 persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as
5 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the
6 petition.

7 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

8 Sec. 7926.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has
9 the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for
10 which the district is created.

11 Sec. 7926.102. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND
12 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the
13 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,
14 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,
15 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

16 Sec. 7926.103. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. Under Section
17 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may design,
18 acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, operate,
19 maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a municipality for
20 operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or
21 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.

22 Sec. 7926.104. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A road
23 project must meet all applicable construction standards, zoning and
24 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each municipality in
25 whose corporate limits the road project is located.

26 (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits
27 of a municipality, the road project must meet all applicable

1 construction standards, subdivision requirements, and regulations
2 of each county in which the road project is located.

3 (c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the
4 Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and
5 specifications of the road project.

6 Sec. 7926.105. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT ORDINANCE
7 OR RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all applicable
8 requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is adopted under
9 Section 54.016 or 54.0165, Water Code, and that consents to the
10 creation of the district or to the inclusion of land in the
11 district.

12 Sec. 7926.106. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district may
13 be divided into two or more new districts only if the district:

14 (1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and

15 (2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes.

16 (b) This chapter applies to any new district created by the
17 division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and
18 duties of the district.

19 (c) Any new district created by the division of the district
20 may not, at the time the new district is created, contain any land
21 outside the area described by Section 2 of the Act creating this
22 chapter.

23 (d) The board, on its own motion or on receipt of a petition
24 signed by the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed value of
25 the real property in the district, may adopt an order dividing the
26 district.

27 (e) The board may adopt an order dividing the district

1 before or after the date the board holds an election under Section
2 7926.003 to confirm the creation of the district and before or after
3 an election under Section 7926.151 to authorize the issuance of
4 bonds.

5 (f) An order dividing the district must:

6 (1) name each new district;

7 (2) include the metes and bounds description of the
8 territory of each new district;

9 (3) appoint temporary directors for each new district;

10 and

11 (4) provide for the division of assets and liabilities
12 between or among the new districts.

13 (g) On or before the 30th day after the date of adoption of
14 an order dividing the district, the district shall file the order
15 with the commission and record the order in the real property
16 records of each county in which the district is located.

17 (h) Any new district created by the division of the district
18 shall hold a confirmation and directors' election as required by
19 Section 7926.003.

20 (i) Any new district created by the division of the district
21 must hold an election as required by this chapter to obtain voter
22 approval before the district may impose a maintenance tax or issue
23 bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes.

24 (j) If the creation of the new district is confirmed, the
25 new district shall provide the election date and results to the
26 commission.

1 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

2 Sec. 7926.151. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a) The
3 district may issue, without an election, bonds and other
4 obligations secured by:

5 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or

6 (2) contract payments described by Section 7926.153.

7 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner
8 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval
9 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds
10 payable from ad valorem taxes.

11 (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem
12 taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a
13 vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an
14 election held for that purpose.

15 Sec. 7926.152. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
16 authorized at an election held under Section 7926.151, the district
17 may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in
18 the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water Code.

19 (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
20 exceed the rate approved at the election.

21 Sec. 7926.153. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with
22 Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than
23 an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from
24 the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of
25 the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters
26 voting at an election held for that purpose.

27 (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a

1 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by
2 the board without further voter approval.

3 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS

4 Sec. 7926.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
5 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations
6 payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,
7 revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any
8 combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district
9 purpose.

10 Sec. 7926.202. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district
11 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the
12 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing
13 direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all
14 or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner
15 provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.

16 Sec. 7926.203. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of
17 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations
18 issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad
19 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the
20 real property in the district.

21 SECTION 2. The Foster Municipal Utility District No. 1 of
22 Montgomery County initially includes all the territory contained in
23 the following area:

24 Being 3,411.960 acres of land located in the Jose Maria De La
25 Garza Survey, Abstract Number 15 and the Cyrus Dikeman Survey,
26 Abstract Number 179, Montgomery County, Texas, being the apparent
27 remainder of those certain tracts described as "Part II, Tracts 7-1

1 and 8" conveyed Foster Timber, LTD by the instrument of record dated
2 February 17, 1995 recorded under File Number 9509573 in the
3 Official Public Records of Real Property of Montgomery County,

25 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
26 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
27 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a

1 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
2 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
3 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
4 Government Code.

5 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
6 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
7 Environmental Quality.

8 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
9 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
10 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
11 representatives within the required time.

12 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
13 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
14 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
15 and accomplished.

16 SECTION 4. (a) If this Act does not receive a two-thirds
17 vote of all the members elected to each house, Subchapter C, Chapter
18 7926, Special District Local Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of
19 this Act, is amended by adding Section 7926.107 to read as follows:

20 Sec. 7926.107. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
21 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

22 (b) This section is not intended to be an expression of a
23 legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c),
24 Article I, Texas Constitution.

25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
