- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) On the effective date of this Act, the board
- 6 of directors of the Fulshear Town Center Management District
- 7 established under Chapter 3903, Special District Local Laws Code,
- 8 is dissolved.
- 9 (b) On the effective date of this Act, the board of
- 10 directors of the Fulshear Town Center Management District is
- 11 reconstituted and is composed of the following directors:

- 18 (c) The terms of the directors appointed under Subsection
- 19 (b) of this section expire June 1, 2016.
- 20 (d) Of the directors who replace a director appointed under
- 21 Subsection (b) of this section, the terms of directors serving in
- 22 positions 1, 2, and 3 expire June 1, 2018, and the terms of
- 23 directors serving in positions 4 and 5 expire June 1, 2020.
- (e) Section 3903.052, Special District Local Laws Code,

- 1 does not apply to this section.
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 3903.061, Special District Local Laws
- 3 Code, is repealed.
- 4 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 5 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 6 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 7 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 8 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 9 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 10 Government Code.
- 11 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 12 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 13 Environmental Quality.
- 14 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 15 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 16 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 17 representatives within the required time.
- 18 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 19 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 20 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 21 and accomplished.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
