H.B. No. 4153

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to the creation of the Montgomery-Grimes Counties  
3 Municipal Utility District No. 146; granting a limited power of  
4 eminent domain; providing authority to issue bonds; providing  
5 authority to impose assessments, fees, and taxes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws  
8 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 7906 to read as follows:

9 CHAPTER 7906. MONTGOMERY-GRIMES COUNTIES MUNICIPAL UTILITY

10 DISTRICT NO. 146

11 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

12 Sec. 7906.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

13 (1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

14 (2) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on  
15 Environmental Quality.

16 (3) "Director" means a board member.

17 (4) "District" means the Montgomery-Grimes Counties  
18 Municipal Utility District No. 146.

19 Sec. 7906.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a  
20 municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI,  
21 Texas Constitution.

22 Sec. 7906.003. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTORS' ELECTION  
23 REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to  
24 confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent

1 directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

2 Sec. 7906.004. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. (a) The  
3 temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 7906.003  
4 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or  
5 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has  
6 consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the  
7 district and to the inclusion of land in the district.

8 (b) Municipal consent to the creation of the district and to  
9 the inclusion of land in the district granted under this section  
10 acts as municipal consent to the creation of any new district  
11 created by the division of the district and to the inclusion of land  
12 in the new district.

13 Sec. 7906.005. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT. (a)  
14 The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit.

15 (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of:  
16 (1) a municipal utility district as provided by  
17 general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and  
18 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that  
19 relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation,  
20 or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or  
21 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.

22 Sec. 7906.006. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The  
23 district is initially composed of the territory described by  
24 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.

25 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of  
26 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the  
27 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process

1 does not affect the district's:

2 (1) organization, existence, or validity;

3 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes  
4 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and  
5 interest on a bond;

6 (3) right to impose a tax; or

7 (4) legality or operation.

8 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

9 Sec. 7906.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is  
10 governed by a board of five elected directors.

11 (b) Except as provided by Section 7906.052, directors serve  
12 staggered four-year terms.

13 Sec. 7906.052. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after  
14 September 1, 2015, the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed  
15 value of the real property in the district may submit a petition to  
16 the commission requesting that the commission appoint as temporary  
17 directors the five persons named in the petition. The commission  
18 shall appoint as temporary directors the five persons named in the  
19 petition.

20 (b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:

21 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under  
22 Section 7906.003; or

23 (2) September 1, 2019.

24 (c) If permanent directors have not been elected under  
25 Section 7906.003 and the terms of the temporary directors have  
26 expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or  
27 reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that

1 expire on the earlier of:

2 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under  
3 Section 7906.003; or

4 (2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the  
5 appointment or reappointment.

6 (d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a  
7 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district  
8 may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the  
9 commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five  
10 persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as  
11 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the  
12 petition.

13 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

14 Sec. 7906.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has  
15 the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for  
16 which the district is created.

17 Sec. 7906.102. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND  
18 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the  
19 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,  
20 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,  
21 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

22 Sec. 7906.103. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. Under Section  
23 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may design,  
24 acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, operate,  
25 maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a municipality for  
26 operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or  
27 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.

1       Sec. 7906.104. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A road  
2 project must meet all applicable construction standards, zoning and  
3 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each municipality in  
4 whose corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction the road  
5 project is located.

6       (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits  
7 or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road  
8 project must meet all applicable construction standards,  
9 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which  
10 the road project is located.

11       (c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the  
12 Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and  
13 specifications of the road project.

14       Sec. 7906.105. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT ORDINANCE  
15 OR RESOLUTION. (a) The district shall comply with all applicable  
16 requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is adopted under  
17 Section 54.016 or 54.0165, Water Code, and that consents to the  
18 creation of the district or to the inclusion of land in the  
19 district.

20       (b) Section 54.016(f), Water Code, does not apply to the  
21 district.

22       Sec. 7906.106. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district may  
23 be divided into two or more new districts only if the district:

- 24               (1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and  
25               (2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes.

26       (b) This chapter applies to any new district created by the  
27 division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and

1 duties of the district.

2 (c) Any new district created by the division of the district  
3 may not, at the time the new district is created, contain any land  
4 outside the area described by Section 2 of the Act creating this  
5 chapter.

6 (d) The board, on its own motion or on receipt of a petition  
7 signed by the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed value of  
8 the real property in the district, may adopt an order dividing the  
9 district.

10 (e) The board may adopt an order dividing the district  
11 before or after the date the board holds an election under Section  
12 7906.003 to confirm the creation of the district and before or after  
13 an election under Section 7906.151 to authorize the issuance of  
14 bonds.

15 (f) An order dividing the district must:

16 (1) name each new district;

17 (2) include the metes and bounds description of the  
18 territory of each new district;

19 (3) appoint temporary directors for each new district;

20 and

21 (4) provide for the division of assets and liabilities  
22 between or among the new districts.

23 (g) On or before the 30th day after the date of adoption of  
24 an order dividing the district, the district shall file the order  
25 with the commission and record the order in the real property  
26 records of each county in which the district is located.

27 (h) Any new district created by the division of the district

1 shall hold a confirmation and directors' election as required by  
2 Section 7906.003.

3 (i) Any new district created by the division of the district  
4 must hold an election as required by this chapter to obtain voter  
5 approval before the district may impose a maintenance tax or issue  
6 bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes.

7 (j) If the creation of the new district is confirmed, the  
8 new district shall provide the election date and results to the  
9 commission.

10 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

11 Sec. 7906.151. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a) The  
12 district may issue, without an election, bonds and other  
13 obligations secured by:

14 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or

15 (2) contract payments described by Section 7906.153.

16 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner  
17 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval  
18 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds  
19 payable from ad valorem taxes.

20 (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem  
21 taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a  
22 vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an  
23 election held for that purpose.

24 Sec. 7906.152. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If  
25 authorized at an election held under Section 7906.151, the district  
26 may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in  
27 the district in accordance with Section [49.107](#), Water Code.

1       (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not  
2 exceed the rate approved at the election.

3       Sec. 7906.153. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with  
4 Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than  
5 an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from  
6 the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of  
7 the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters  
8 voting at an election held for that purpose.

9       (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a  
10 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by  
11 the board without further voter approval.

12                   SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS

13       Sec. 7906.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER  
14 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations  
15 payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,  
16 revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any  
17 combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district  
18 purpose.

19       Sec. 7906.202. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district  
20 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the  
21 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing  
22 direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all  
23 or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner  
24 provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.

25       Sec. 7906.203. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of  
26 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations  
27 issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad



1 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the  
2 real property in the district.

3 SECTION 2. The Montgomery-Grimes Counties Municipal  
4 Utility District No. 146 initially includes all the territory  
5 contained in the following area:

6 428.212 Acres

7 Joseph G. Ferguson Survey, A-221

8 Montgomery County, Texas

9 Being 428.212 acres of land situated in the Joseph G. Ferguson  
10 Survey, A-221, Montgomery County, Texas, and being out of a  
11 residual of a certain 1936.077 acres of land as described in deed  
12 recorded under County Clerk's File No. 2007-037712 of the Real  
13 Property Records of Montgomery County, Texas, said 428.212 acres of  
14 land being more particularly described by metes and bounds as  
15 follows:

16 BEGINNING at a concrete monument found in the west line of F.M.  
17 1486, a 110 foot right-of-way, for the southeast corner of Blake  
18 Ranch as described in deed recorded under County Clerk's File  
19 No. 9366055 of the Real Property Records of Montgomery County,  
20 Texas, same being the northeast corner and POINT OF BEGINNING of  
21 the herein described tract;

22 THENCE South 02 degrees 33 minutes 01 seconds East, along the west  
23 line of said F.M. 1486 and the east boundary line of the said  
24 1936.077 acres of land, same being the east boundary line of the  
25 herein described tract, a distance of 2677.01 feet to a 5/8 inch  
26 iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for the northeast corner of Lot  
27 1, Block 8, Crown Ranch Section One Amending Plat No. 1, according

1 to the map or plat thereof recorded in Cabinet Z, Sheets 755 thru  
2 759 of the Map Records of Montgomery County, Texas, and the  
3 southeast corner of the herein described tract;  
4 THENCE North 85 degrees 35 minutes 50 seconds West, along the north  
5 boundary line of Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, Block 8, of said Crown Ranch  
6 and the southerly boundary line of the herein described tract, a  
7 distance of 1128.30 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap  
8 (Moyer) set for an angle point;  
9 THENCE South 59 degrees 34 minutes 02 seconds West, continuing  
10 along the north boundary line of said Lot 4 and the north boundary  
11 line of Lots 5 and 6, Block 8 of said Crown Ranch and continuing  
12 along the south boundary line of the herein described tract, a  
13 distance of 635.56 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap  
14 (Moyer) set for the northwest corner of said Lot 6 and a southerly  
15 corner of the herein described tract;  
16 THENCE in a southeasterly direction along the west boundary line of  
17 said Lot 6 and a southerly boundary line of the herein described  
18 tract along a non-tangent curve to the left having as its elements:  
19 a radius of 616.14 feet, a central angle of 37 degrees 40 minutes 18  
20 seconds, an arc length of 405.11 feet, and a chord bearing of South  
21 23 degrees 38 minutes 52 seconds East, a distance of 397.85 feet to  
22 a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set in the north line of  
23 Crown Ranch Boulevard (a northwesterly cut-back corner) for the  
24 southwest corner of said Lot 6 and a southerly corner of the herein  
25 described tract;  
26 THENCE South 37 degrees 53 minutes 49 seconds West, continuing  
27 along the northwesterly line of said Crown Ranch Boulevard and the

1 southerly boundary line of the herein described tract, a distance  
2 of 60.78 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for  
3 the most easterly southeast corner of Restricted Reserve "F" of  
4 said Crown Ranch and a southerly corner of the herein described  
5 tract;

6 THENCE in a northwesterly direction along the northeast boundary  
7 line of said Restricted Reserve "F" and continuing along the  
8 southerly boundary line of the herein described tract along a  
9 non-tangent curve to the right having as its elements: a radius of  
10 676.14 feet, a central angle of 27 degrees 37 minutes 46 seconds, an  
11 arc length of 326.05 feet, and a chord bearing of North 29 degrees  
12 31 minutes 46 seconds West, a distance of 322.90 feet to a 5/8 inch  
13 iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for the northeast corner of  
14 said Restricted Reserve "F" and a southerly corner of the herein  
15 described tract;

16 THENCE South 59 degrees 34 minutes 02 seconds West, along the north  
17 boundary line of said Restricted Reserve "F" and continuing along  
18 the southerly boundary line of the herein described tract, a  
19 distance of 657.92 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap  
20 (Moyer) set for the northwest corner of said Restricted Reserve "F"  
21 and a southerly corner of the herein described tract;

22 THENCE South 14 degrees 38 minutes 43 seconds West, along the west  
23 boundary line of said Restricted Reserve "F" and continuing along  
24 the southerly boundary line of the herein described tract, a  
25 distance of 243.59 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap  
26 (Moyer) set for an angle point;

27 THENCE South 02 degrees 30 minutes 07 seconds East, continuing

1 along the west boundary line of said Restricted Reserve "F" and the  
2 southerly boundary line of the herein described tract, a distance  
3 of 89.62 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set in  
4 the north line of said Crown Ranch Boulevard for the southwest  
5 corner of said Restricted Reserve "F" and a southerly corner of the  
6 herein described tract;

7 THENCE South 87 degrees 29 minutes 53 seconds West, along the north  
8 line of said Crown Ranch Boulevard and continuing along the  
9 southerly boundary line of the herein described tract, a distance  
10 of 850.45 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for  
11 the southeast corner of Lot 1, Block 7, of said Crown Ranch and a  
12 southerly corner of the herein described tract;

13 THENCE North 02 degrees 30 minutes 07 seconds West, along the east  
14 boundary line of said Lot 1, Block 7 and continuing along the  
15 southerly boundary line of the herein described tract, a distance  
16 of 405.55 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for  
17 the northeast corner of said Lot 1, Block 7 and a southerly corner  
18 of the herein described tract;

19 THENCE South 87 degrees 29 minutes 53 seconds West, along the north  
20 boundary line of Lots 1 and 2, Block 7 and continuing along the  
21 southerly boundary line of the herein described tract, a distance  
22 of 383.12 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for  
23 the northwest corner of said Lot 2, Block 7 and a southerly corner  
24 of the herein described tract;

25 THENCE South 02 degrees 30 minutes 07 seconds East, along the west  
26 boundary line of said Lot 2 and continuing along the southerly  
27 boundary line of the herein described tract, a distance of 380.55

1 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set in the north  
2 line of said Crown Ranch Boulevard for the southwest corner of said  
3 Lot 2 and a southerly corner of the herein described tract;  
4 THENCE South 87 degrees 29 minutes 53 seconds West, along the north  
5 line of said Crown Ranch Boulevard and continuing along the  
6 southerly boundary line of the herein described tract, a distance  
7 of 60.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for  
8 the southeast corner of Lot 1, Block 6 of said Crown Ranch and a  
9 southerly corner of the herein described tract;  
10 THENCE North 02 degrees 30 minutes 07 seconds West, along the east  
11 boundary line of said a Lot 1, Block 6 and continuing along the  
12 southerly boundary line of the herein described tract, a distance  
13 of 380.55 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for  
14 the northeast corner of said Lot 1, Block 6 and a southerly corner  
15 of the herein described tract;  
16 THENCE South 87 degrees 29 minutes 53 second West, along the north  
17 boundary lines of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, Block 6 of said Crown Ranch  
18 Section One and continuing along the southerly boundary line of the  
19 herein described tract, a distance of 865.08 feet to a 5/8 inch iron  
20 rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for the northeast corner of Lot 1,  
21 Block 5, of said Crown Ranch and a southerly angle point of the  
22 herein described tract;  
23 THENCE North 59 degrees 17 minutes 57 seconds West, along the  
24 northeast boundary line of Lots 1, 2, and 3, Block 5 of said Crown  
25 Ranch and along the southwesterly boundary line of the herein  
26 described tract, a distance of 451.13 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod  
27 with survey cap (Moyer) set for the common corner of Lots 3 and 4,

1 Block 5 of said Crown Ranch and an angle point of the herein  
2 described tract;  
3 THENCE North 47 degrees 07 minutes 57 seconds West, along the  
4 northeast boundary line of Lots 4 and 5, Block 5 of said Crown Ranch  
5 and continuing along the southwesterly boundary line of the herein  
6 described tract, a distance of 298.12 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod  
7 with survey cap (Moyer) set for the common corner of Lots 5 and 6,  
8 Block 5 of said Crown Ranch and an angle point of the herein  
9 described tract;  
10 THENCE North 37 degrees 48 minutes 49 seconds West, along the  
11 northeast boundary line of Lots 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10, Block 5, of said  
12 Crown Ranch and continuing along the southwesterly boundary line of  
13 the herein described tract, a distance of 901.31 feet to a 5/8 inch  
14 iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set in a curve for the north corner  
15 of said Lot 10 common to a southerly corner of the herein described  
16 tract;  
17 THENCE in a southwesterly direction along the northwest boundary  
18 line of said Lot 10 and continuing along the southwesterly boundary  
19 line of the herein described tract along a non-tangent curve to the  
20 right having as its elements: a radius of 1030.00 feet, a central  
21 angle of 01 degrees 09 minutes 44 seconds, an arc length of 20.90  
22 feet, and a chord bearing of South 51 degrees 36 minutes 18 seconds  
23 West, a distance of 20.89 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap  
24 (Moyer) set for the end of the curve;  
25 THENCE South 52 degrees 11 minutes 11 seconds West, continuing  
26 along the northwest boundary line of said Lot 10 and continuing  
27 along the southwesterly boundary line of the herein described

1 tract, a distance of 332.11 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey  
2 cap (Moyer) set in the northeast line of Crown Ranch Boulevard, a 60  
3 foot private right-of-way, for the southwest corner of said Lot 10,  
4 same being a southerly corner of the herein described tract;  
5 THENCE North 37 degrees 48 minutes 49 seconds West, along the  
6 northeast line of said Crown Ranch Boulevard and continuing along  
7 the southwesterly boundary line of the herein described tract, a  
8 distance of 60.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap  
9 (Moyer) set for the southeast corner of Lot 1, Block 4, of said  
10 Crown Ranch Section One and a southerly corner of the herein  
11 described tract;  
12 THENCE North 52 degrees 11 minutes 10 seconds East, along the  
13 southeast boundary line of said Lot 1 and continuing along the  
14 southwesterly boundary line of the herein described tract, a  
15 distance of 332.11 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap for  
16 the beginning of a curve;  
17 THENCE in a northeasterly direction continuing along the southeast  
18 boundary line of said Lot 1 and continuing along the southwesterly  
19 boundary line of the herein described tract along a curve to the  
20 left having as its elements: a radius of 970.00 feet, a central  
21 angle of 01 degrees 11 minutes 13 seconds, an arc length of 20.09  
22 feet, and a chord bearing of North 51 degrees 35 minutes 34 seconds  
23 East, a distance of 20.09 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with survey cap  
24 (Moyer) set for the northeast corner of said Lot 1 and a southerly  
25 corner of the herein described tract;  
26 THENCE North 43 degrees 36 minutes 42 seconds West, along the  
27 northeast boundary line of Lots 1, 2, and 3, Block 4 of said Crown

1 Ranch, and continuing along the southwesterly boundary line of the  
2 herein described tract, a distance of 552.90 feet to a 5/8 inch iron  
3 rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for an angle point;  
4 THENCE North 58 degrees 26 minutes 29 seconds West, along the  
5 northeast boundary line of said Lots 3, 4, 5, and 6, Block 4, of said  
6 Crown Ranch and continuing along the southwesterly boundary line of  
7 the herein described tract, a distance of 561.07 feet to a 5/8 inch  
8 iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for an angle point;  
9 THENCE North 73 degrees 22 minutes 49 seconds West, along the  
10 northeast boundary line of Lots 6, 7, 8, and Restricted Reserve "E",  
11 Block 4 of said Crown Ranch, and the southwesterly boundary line of  
12 the herein described tract, a distance of 561.07 feet to a 5/8 inch  
13 iron rod with survey cap (Moyer) set for an angle point;  
14 THENCE North 87 degrees 16 minutes 13 seconds West, along the north  
15 boundary line of Restricted Reserve "E" and Lot 9, Block 4, of said  
16 Crown Ranch and continuing along the southwesterly boundary line  
17 of the herein described tract, a distance of 247.65 feet to a point  
18 for the southeast corner of Restricted Reserve "G" of Crown Ranch  
19 Section Three, according to the map or plat thereof recorded in  
20 Cabinet Z, Sheet 1208 of the Map Records of Montgomery County, Texas  
21 and a northwest corner of the herein described tract;  
22 THENCE North 27 degrees 21 minutes 07 seconds East, along the east  
23 boundary line of said Restricted Reserve "G", southeast boundary

10 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,

12 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has  
13 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on  
14 Environmental Quality.

15 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed  
16 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the  
17 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of  
18 representatives within the required time.

19 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this  
20 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect  
21 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled  
22 and accomplished.

23 SECTION 4. (a) If this Act does not receive a two-thirds  
24 vote of all the members elected to each house, Subchapter C, Chapter  
25 7906, Special District Local Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of  
26 this Act, is amended by adding Section 7906.107 to read as follows:

27 Sec. 7906.107. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may

1 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

2           (b) This section is not intended to be an expression of a  
3 legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c),  
4 Article I, Texas Constitution.

5           SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
