## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The dynamic community of Nocona in North Texas has 2 earned distinction for itself in recent years as a center for the preservation and celebration of classic American automobiles; and 3 WHEREAS, Situated on the historic Chisholm Trail, Nocona is 4 5 home impressive automotive museums created by entrepreneurs Pete and Barbara Horton; the dozens of vintage, 6 7 classic, and muscle cars found at the facilities are carefully maintained by museum director Billy Dean Dobbs; and 8 9 WHEREAS, The Horton Classic Car Museum is housed in a former Ford dealership on West Walnut Street, and it features more than 120 10 11 automobiles, including over 40 Corvettes from nearly every model 12 year between 1953 and 1978, as well as a variety of Packards, Plymouths, Oldsmobiles, and a Studebaker, among other makes; and 13 14 WHEREAS, The Horton Motor Company Museum is situated a few blocks away in the town's picturesque former Chevrolet dealership, 15 and it contains 16 more cars from the Hortons' collection, 16 including a 1965 Chevy Chevelle SS Malibu Z-16, a 1970 Plymouth 17 18 Hemi-Cuda "Tribute" Convertible, and a 1968 Shelby GT-500 Cobra Mustang signed by legendary automobile designer Carroll Shelby; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Each May, the community proudly hosts Cruisin' 21 Nocona, one of the fastest growing events of its kind in the Lone Star State; for three days, the town attracts classic cars and car 22 23 enthusiasts from across the state and region; events include a

- 7 RESOLVED, That the 84th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 8 hereby designate the town of Nocona as the official Classic Car
- 9 Capital of Texas; and, be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section
- 11 391.003(e), Government Code, this designation remain in effect
- 12 until its 10th anniversary.
