CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, For nearly a century, the South Texas community of
- 2 Poteet has been known across the Lone Star State as a source of
- 3 delicious strawberries and as the host of a renowned annual
- 4 strawberry festival; and
- 5 WHEREAS, In 1911, city founders Henry and Ida Mumme began to
- 6 grow strawberries in their kitchen garden, and within 10 years, the
- 7 community's strawberry crop had become one of its most successful
- 8 products; local citizens invited residents of nearby San Antonio to
- 9 sample the town's strawberries in 1921, and the San Antonio
- 10 Express-News ran a story headlined "Crimson Berries Beckon Hungry
- 11 Tourists to Poteet"; and
- WHEREAS, Building on the city's reputation, the Poteet Rotary
- 13 Club staged the first Poteet Strawberry Festival in April 1948,
- 14 hoping to provide an incentive for veterans of World War II to
- 15 return to area farms; the club also promoted more careful packing of
- 16 the crop so that each buyer would receive a uniform pint, flat, or
- 17 crate of berries; and
- WHEREAS, Over the course of the past 67 years, the festival
- 19 has grown to become one of the signature springtime events in South
- 20 Texas, drawing 100,000 visitors and contributing up to \$12 million
- 21 to the local economy each year; in addition to the strawberries
- 22 themselves, the popular gathering features live country music, a
- 23 rodeo, and a food show and auction; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The Poteet Strawberry Festival Association has also

- 1 presented college scholarships to deserving local students for the
- 2 past two decades; it currently gives away 10 scholarships each
- 3 year, while many of the more than 30 churches, schools, and civic
- 4 organizations that participate in the festival donate scholarships
- 5 as well; and
- 6 WHEREAS, This sweet, juicy, and colorful fruit is a delight
- 7 to behold and to taste, and for many years, the citizens of Poteet
- 8 have made the strawberry both a source of prosperity and a cause for
- 9 celebration; now, therefore, be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the 84th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 11 hereby designate Poteet as the official Strawberry Capital of
- 12 Texas; and, be it further
- 13 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section
- 14 391.003(e), Government Code, this designation remain in effect
- 15 until the 10th anniversary of its designation.
