

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Stephen C. Head was appointed chancellor of the
2 Lone Star College System in the summer of 2014; and

3 WHEREAS, Over the course of more than three decades with the
4 system, Dr. Head has worked tirelessly to promote academic rigor
5 while expanding access to higher education and improving student
6 completion rates; he has maintained a strong focus on aligning
7 workforce programs with community needs, and he has fostered
8 collaborative agreements with educational, business, and civic
9 organizations; and

10 WHEREAS, This dynamic administrator previously served the
11 system in a number of high-level positions, including as president
12 of Lone Star College-North Harris, executive vice chancellor,
13 acting chief executive officer, interim president of Montgomery
14 College, and president of Kingwood College; he holds both
15 bachelor's and master's degrees from Lamar University, and he
16 completed a Ph.D. in history at Texas Tech University; a lecturer in
17 the higher education doctoral program at Sam Houston State
18 University, he also teaches classes in community college leadership
19 and higher education finance, and he chairs the North Harris County
20 Education Alliance; and

21 WHEREAS, Deeply engaged in the wider community, Dr. Head
22 serves on the boards of the Greater Greenspoint Tax Increment
23 Reinvestment Zone, the Greenspoint Management District, and the
24 Greens Bayou Corridor Coalition and chairs the North Houston

1 Economic Development Council, of which he is a founding member; he
2 has also served on the boards of five area chambers of commerce and
3 several other economic development groups and has chaired the board
4 of Kingwood Medical Hospital; the recipient of numerous accolades,
5 he was named Citizen of the Year by both the Houston
6 Intercontinental Chamber of Commerce and the Acres Homes Chamber of
7 Commerce; and

8 WHEREAS, Dr. Head brings to his office incisive leadership,
9 deep experience, and a passionate commitment to the mission of
10 higher education, and he is making an immeasurable contribution to
11 the development of the Lone Star College System; now, therefore, be
12 it

13 RESOLVED, That the 84th Legislature of the State of Texas
14 hereby congratulate Dr. Stephen C. Head on his appointment as
15 chancellor of the Lone Star College System and extend to him sincere
16 best wishes for continued success; and, be it further

18 prepared for Dr. Head as an expression of high regard by the Texas
19 House of Representatives and Senate.
