## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, As in previous sessions, bills have been introduced 2 in both chambers of the 84th Texas Legislature to modify current statutes prescribing how legally required notices are posted and 3 advertised to the general public; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Abundant testimony against these measures in past public hearings has cited statistics that public notice placed on 6

problems with archiving Internet notices, raised questions about 8 9 removing oversight and reducing transparency, and questioned the cost-effectiveness of posting notices on the Internet or through 10

the Internet would not reach a large number of Texans, demonstrated

social media; there has also been testimony that publishing public 11

12 notice on the Internet or through social media would be efficient

13 and cost-effective and would increase audience reach and

transparency; and 14

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WHEREAS, It is incumbent on the State of Texas to ensure that 15 public notification about vital information be efficient and 16 17 effective, and the issue of posting and advertising public notices on the Internet merits further examination; now, therefore, be it 18

RESOLVED, That the 84th Legislature of the State of Texas hereby request the lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house 20 of representatives to create a joint interim committee to study the issue of advertising public notices; and, be it further 22

23 RESOLVED, That the committee's proceedings and operations be governed by such general rules and policies for joint interim 24

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1 committees as the 84th Legislature may adopt.
