- 11 cyberspace, 24 hours a day, seven days a week, as individuals,
- 12 political parties, lobbyists, businesses, nonprofit organizations,
- 13 and countless other stakeholders communicate their thoughts about
- 14 current and proposed legislation 140 characters at a time; and
- 15 WHEREAS, These comments can range widely, from the solemn to
- 16 the comical, from the serious to the frivolous, and from the polite
- 17 to the not-so-polite, and taken together, they make up a ceaseless,
- 18 real-time, and sometimes raw but always fascinating
- 19 stream-of-consciousness accounting of what Texans want their
- 20 legislators to know; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Social media is transforming political discourse in
- 22 Texas, across the nation, and around the world, and #txlege
- 23 represents an opportunity for every Texan to follow and participate
- 24 in this dynamic and freewheeling debate of the issues of the day;
