CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Every day, peace officers devote themselves to the 2 security and well-being of the people they serve, and Operation 3 Blue Shield is committed to supporting them in their vital mission; 4 and

5 WHEREAS, Operation Blue Shield is a community-centric initiative designed to promote better understanding and improved 6 7 relations between citizens and law enforcement; the campaign encourages open and constructive dialogue between police and the 8 9 wider community and recognizes the importance of acknowledging diverse backgrounds and perspectives; toward that end, it raises 10 funds to underwrite public safety endeavors and to help meet the 11 12 evolving resource needs of peace officers; and
