A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing that a person
- 2 holding a statewide elective office automatically vacates office on
- 3 announcing a candidacy or becoming a candidate for another elective
- 4 office before December 1 of the last full odd-numbered year of the
- 5 person's term of office.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 65-a to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 65-a. If a person who holds a statewide elective office
- 10 announces the person's candidacy, or in fact becomes a candidate,
- 11 in any general, special, or primary election for any office of
- 12 profit or trust under the laws of this State or the United States
- 13 other than the office then held at any time before December 1 of the
- 14 last full odd-numbered year before the term of office then held
- 15 expires, that announcement or candidacy constitutes an automatic
- 16 resignation from the office then held.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing that a person
- 21 holding a statewide elective office automatically vacates office on
- 22 announcing a candidacy or becoming a candidate for another elective
- 23 office before December 1 of the last full odd-numbered year of the
- 24 person's term of office."
