A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing certain persons
- 2 under the age of 18 to vote in a primary election.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article VI, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 5 adding Section 1a to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 1a. The legislature by general law may provide for
- 7 voting in a primary election by a person who:
- 8 (1) will be 18 years of age or older on the date of the
- 9 <u>subsequent general election for state and county officers; and</u>
- 10 (2) satisfies the other applicable requirements for
- 11 eligibility to vote.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing a person
- 16 who will be 18 years of age or older on the date of the general
- 17 election for state and county officers to vote in the preceding
- 18 primary election."
