A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 applying to the Congress of the United States to call a convention
- 2 under Article V of the United States Constitution for the limited
- 3 purpose of proposing an amendment to the constitution to impose
- 4 fiscal restraints on the federal government.
- 5 WHEREAS, The drafters of the United States Constitution
- 6 empowered state legislatures to be guardians of liberty against
- 7 abuses of power by the federal government; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The federal government has abused its power by
- 9 creating a crushing national debt through improper and imprudent
- 10 spending; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The federal government has abused its power by
- 12 invading the legitimate role of the states through the manipulative
- 13 process of federal mandates that are to a great extent unfunded; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The federal government has ceased to abide by a
- 15 proper interpretation of the United States Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, In 1977 the 65th Texas Legislature submitted to the
- 17 federal government H.C.R. No. 31 requesting Congress to prepare and
- 18 submit to the several states an amendment to the United States
- 19 Constitution providing for a federal balanced budget, or
- 20 alternatively requesting Congress to call a constitutional
- 21 convention for the purpose of proposing such an amendment; and
- WHEREAS, Congress has not acted to amend the United States
- 23 Constitution to provide for a federal balanced budget or to
- 24 otherwise impose fiscal restraints on the federal government; and

- 1 WHEREAS, It is the solemn duty of state legislatures to
- 2 protect the liberty of the people and of future generations by
- 3 proposing amendments to the United States Constitution that place
- 4 clear restraints on federal power; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution
- 6 authorizes the several state legislatures to restrict the power of
- 7 the federal government through the amendment process; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution provides
- 9 that on application of the legislatures of two-thirds of the
- 10 several states Congress shall call a convention for the purpose of
- 11 proposing amendments to the constitution; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the 84th Texas Legislature hereby applies to
- 13 Congress to call a convention under Article V of the United States
- 14 Constitution for the limited purpose of proposing an amendment to
- 15 the constitution to impose fiscal restraints on the federal
- 16 government; and, be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That, unless rescinded by a succeeding
- 18 legislature, this application by the 84th Texas Legislature
- 19 constitutes a continuing application in accordance with Article V
- 20 of the United States Constitution until at least two-thirds of the
- 21 legislatures of the several states have applied to Congress to call
- 22 a convention for the limited purpose of proposing an amendment to
- 23 the constitution to impose fiscal restraints on the federal
- 24 government; and, be it further
- 25 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official
- 26 copies of this resolution to the president of the United States, to
- 27 the speaker of the House of Representatives and the president of the

- 1 Senate of the Congress of the United States, and to all members of
- 2 the Texas delegation to Congress with the request that this
- 3 resolution be officially entered in the Congressional Record as an
- 4 application to Congress for a convention under Article V of the
- 5 United States Constitution for the limited purpose of proposing an
- 6 amendment to the constitution to impose fiscal restraints on the
- 7 federal government; and, be it further
- 8 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official
- 9 copies of this resolution to the secretaries of state and to the
- 10 presiding officers of the legislatures of the several states with
- 11 the request that they join this state in applying to Congress for a
- 12 convention under Article V of the United States Constitution for
- 13 the limited purpose of proposing an amendment to the constitution
- 14 to impose fiscal restraints on the federal government.
