A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation the total assessed value of the
- 3 residence homestead of a veteran or current member of the armed
- 4 services of the United States while the veteran or current service
- 5 member participates in a veterans court program.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 1-s to read as follows:
- 9 <u>Sec. 1-s.</u> The legislature by general law may exempt from ad
- 10 valorem taxation the total assessed value of the residence
- 11 homestead of a veteran or current member of the armed services of
- 12 the United States who is a participant in a veterans court program
- 13 <u>during the period in which the veteran or current service member</u>
- 14 participates in the program. The legislature by general law may
- 15 provide additional eligibility requirements for the exemption.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 20 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation the total assessed
- 21 value of the residence homestead of a veteran or current member of
- 22 the armed services of the United States while the veteran or current
- 23 service member participates in a veterans court program."
