A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature

- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation a portion of the assessed value

- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 1-p to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1-p. The legislature by general law may exempt from ad
- 9 valorem taxation a portion of the assessed value of property used to
- 10 provide housing to persons with disabilities in an amount equal to
- 11 the costs the owner of the property incurs to maintain, operate, and
- 12 make improvements to the property. The legislature may provide
- 13 eligibility requirements for the exemption authorized by this
- 14 section and may provide for the manner of determining the amount of
- 15 the exemption to which a property owner is entitled in a tax year.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 20 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation a portion of the
- 21 assessed value of certain real property used to provide housing to
- 22 certain persons with disabilities."
