1           WHEREAS, The Oak Cliff Coalition for the Arts is sponsoring  
2 its annual Cinco de Mayo parade and street festival in the Oak Cliff  
3 area of Dallas in May 2015; and

4           WHEREAS, Dedicated to promoting the arts and education, the  
5 Oak Cliff Coalition for the Arts sponsors cultural events and funds  
6 scholarships in the community; and

7           WHEREAS, Commemorating the victory of Mexican troops led by  
8 Texas-born General Ignacio Zaragoza over the French at the Battle  
9 of Puebla on May 5, 1862, the annual Oak Cliff Cinco de Mayo parade  
10 includes floats, marching bands, school groups, and other community  
11 participants; and

12           WHEREAS, The celebration's street festival will feature  
13 performances by local musicians and dancers, as well as booths  
14 offering food and local merchandise and a Community Pavilion;  
15 proceeds from the festival will help support the coalition's  
16 scholarship fund; and

17           WHEREAS, Drawing as many as 20,000 people every year, the Oak  
18 Cliff Cinco de Mayo parade and street festival is a highly  
19 anticipated event, bringing together neighbors and visitors to  
20 commemorate a vital moment in history and to share in the traditions  
21 of a rich and dynamic culture; now, therefore, be it

22           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas  
23 Legislature hereby recognize the 2015 Oak Cliff Coalition for the  
24 Arts Cinco de Mayo parade and street festival and extend to its
