1 WHEREAS, Imogene Giesinger Elementary School in Conroe has
2 been named a National Blue Ribbon School by the U.S. Department of
3 Education; and

4 WHEREAS, The Blue Ribbon designation recognizes schools that
5 have maintained superior levels of academic achievement or that are
6 making significant gains while serving an economically
7 disadvantaged student population; presented with the honor for its
8 overall academic excellence, Giesinger Elementary is among 25
9 campuses in Texas and fewer than 300 public and private schools in
10 the nation to be selected as Blue Ribbon Schools in 2014; and

11 WHEREAS, Under the skillful guidance of principal Rebecca
12 Shepard Page, Giesinger Elementary has been rated "Exemplary" by
13 the Texas Education Agency for three of the past five years, and in
14 2014, the school was named a Title I Reward School based on student
15 performance and improvement; these accomplishments are a testament
16 to the school's success in creating an engaging learning
17 environment in which the individual strengths and needs of each
18 student are considered, as well as to its productive efforts to
19 encourage the involvement of parents and community volunteers in
20 the education process; and

22 the teachers and students of Giesinger Elementary School have built
23 an impressive record of scholastic success, and they may take great
24 pride in earning this prestigious honor; now, therefore, be it
