- 2 who passed away on November 30, 2013, at the age of 88; and
- WHEREAS, Born in Waco on June 22, 1925, to H. S. and Irna
- 4 Beard, Pat Beard attended Waco High School and served in the
- 5 U.S. Army during World War II; he went on to earn his bachelor's
- 6 degree from Baylor University in 1947 and his juris doctorate from

- 9 in 1952, when he began practicing law with his father;
- 10 subsequently, he partnered with David Kultgen to found Beard &
- 11 Kultgen, and the firm later merged with another partnership to form
- 12 Beard, Kultgen, Brophy, Bostwick, Dickson, and Squires; known as a
- 13 brilliant attorney, Mr. Beard frequently championed the rights of
- 14 the underprivileged and disenfranchised in his more than five
- 15 decades practicing law; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Outside of his professional ventures, Mr. Beard
- 17 generously donated his time and expertise to a number of nonprofit
- 18 organizations; he was a 33rd degree Scottish Rite Mason and served
- 19 on the board of the Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children; he
- 20 was also a staunch Democrat and supported many local and national
- 21 candidates; in his leisure time, he enjoyed playing tennis with
- 22 friends; and
- WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Mr. Beard shared nearly five
- 24 decades with his wife, the former Martha Sue George, whom he married

- 1 in 1953 after meeting her on a blind date in Washington, D.C.;
- 2 together the couple raised five beloved children, Carey, Mike,
- 3 Bramlet, Joe, and Bob; and
- WHEREAS, Pat Beard brought to his many endeavors compassion,
- 5 unfailing integrity, and generosity of spirit, and his legacy of
- 6 good works remains to inspire all those who were privileged to share
