12 championship game; and

WHEREAS, The Eagles jumped out to a quick lead against

14 Cypress Ranch High School in the title contest, as quarterback

15 Kyler Murray connected with teammate Cody Butler for a touchdown

16 pass to put Allen ahead 7-0; Cypress Ranch pulled to within four

17 points late in the second quarter, but the Eagles' offense

18 responded with a last-minute touchdown drive to take a 21-10 lead

19 into halftime; the Allen players continued their fine performance

20 in the second half, as they overwhelmed their opponent on both sides

21 of the ball on their way to an impressive 47-16 victory; and

WHEREAS, The triumph extended Allen's current winning streak

to an exceptional 43 games; moreover, it gave the Eagles the

24 distinction of being one of just four teams to have collected three
