3 Baytown on December 1, 2014, at the age of 84; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Ingleside on October 21, 1930, to William
5 and Viola White, Charles White grew up in Baytown, where he
6 continued to reside for the rest of his life; a graduate of Robert
7 E. Lee High School, he earned a business degree from The University
8 of Texas; in 1955, he founded White Supply Company, which he
9 operated until his retirement in 1990; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. White was an active member of the Rotary Club of
11 Baytown for more than 50 years; recognized as a Paul Harris Fellow
12 by the organization, he was further honored when the club
13 established a Service Above Self scholarship in his name; in his
14 leisure time, he enjoyed hunting, fishing, and taking photographs,
15 and he was especially fond of sharing stories and jokes; and

16 WHEREAS, For nearly six decades, Mr. White enjoyed the love
17 and support of his wife, the former Shirley Stassi; they were the
18 proud parents of three children, Lu Ann, Mark, and Matthew, and in
19 later years, Mr. White delighted in the company of his seven
20 grandchildren; and

21 WHEREAS, Charles White treasured the time he spent in the
22 company of his family and friends, and those he leaves behind will
23 in turn cherish their memories of this kind and caring man; now,
24 therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas
2 Legislature pay tribute to the life of Charles Fisher White and
3 extend sincere condolences to his family: to his daughter, Lu Ann
