1 WHEREAS, Jackson S. Riggins of Boy Scouts of America Troop
2 No. 405 in Georgetown has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and this
3 accomplishment truly merits special recognition; and

4 WHEREAS, Receiving the Eagle Scout badge is a significant
5 honor, bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the
6 scouting movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding
7 criteria, Mr. Riggins earned 33 merit badges, recorded 104 days and
8 nights of camping, and took part in 61 service projects totaling 261
9 hours; he successfully completed an Eagle Scout project, which
10 involved removing an invasive plant species known as mustard

13 young Texan has demonstrated outstanding leadership ability
14 throughout his scouting career, winning the respect and admiration
15 of the fellow members of his troop as he worked toward the highest
16 rank that the organization offers; and

18 excellence and a perseverance in the pursuit of his goals that have
19 proven him worthy to stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed
20 reflect with pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it

22 Legislature hereby congratulate Jackson S. Riggins on achieving
23 the rank of Eagle Scout and extend to him sincere best wishes for
