RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, On February 18 and 19, 2015, members of the
- 2 Nacogdoches County Chamber of Commerce, Leadership Nacogdoches,
- 3 and Stephen F. Austin State University and its Student Government
- 4 and Alumni Associations are visiting Austin to celebrate
- 5 Nacogdoches-SFA Days at the State Capitol; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Nacogdoches is the site of a Caddo Native American
- 7 settlement and a Spanish mission established in 1716; founded by
- 8 Antonio Gil Y'Barbo, it received designation from Spain as a pueblo
- 9 in 1779, and today it proudly calls itself the first town in Texas,
- 10 and it has also been designated the official Garden Capital of
- 11 Texas; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The city became an important gateway for trade with
- 13 the French and later the Americans, and claims among its lengthy
- 14 list of Texas milestones being home to the first English-language
- 15 newspaper, oil well, and two-story building, as well as the state's
- 16 inaugural district court session; the nine flags flown over the
- 17 city include those of three short-lived early republics; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Today, the vintage charm of Nacogdoches brings
- 19 myriad tourists, who explore such attractions as the Old Stone
- 20 Fort, the Victorian homes along Mound Street, the 19th-century
- 21 buildings of Millard's Crossing, and the quaint antique shops and
- 22 restaurants along brick downtown streets; many also come to enjoy
- 23 recreational activities at Lake Nacogdoches, Lake Naconiche, and
- 24 Sam Rayburn Reservoir, all known for their bass fishing; in

- 1 addition to tourism, the primary industries of the area include
- 2 agricultural services, manufacturing, and oil and gas; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Education has been an important part of the area's
- 4 economy since Stephen F. Austin State University opened its doors
- 5 to 158 students on September 18, 1923; its alumni association was
- 6 organized just five years later and has worked diligently through
- 7 the years to support the school, which now has an enrollment of
- 8 approximately 13,000 students; SFA boasts an exceptionally scenic
- 9 campus recognized for the SFA Gardens and also operates a beef and
- 10 poultry farm, a dairy farm, an experimental forest, a forestry
- 11 field station, and the Waters of East Texas Center; its observatory
- 12 is the second largest not only in Texas but also in the Central Time
- 13 Zone; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Beautifully situated in the Texas Forest Country,
- 15 Nacogdoches is attracting active retired Texans; it was one of the
- 16 first three communities in Texas recognized as a Go Texan certified
- 17 retirement community because of its cultural and sporting events,
- 18 health care, safety, and continuing education opportunities; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The combination of numerous amenities and a
- 20 neighborly atmosphere makes Nacogdoches a splendid place to live,
- 21 work, and study, and it is a pleasure to welcome those representing
- 22 the many facets of this vibrant part of the Lone Star State; now,
- 23 therefore, be it

- 25 Legislature hereby recognize February 18 and 19, 2015, as
- 26 Nacogdoches-SFA Days at the State Capitol and extend to the
