1 WHEREAS, Family and friends will forever treasure their 2 memories of Dallas firefighter William Scott Tanksley, who died in 3 the line of duty on February 10, 2014, at the age of 40; and WHEREAS, A 15-year veteran of the Dallas Fire-Rescue 4 5 Department, Mr. Tanksley worked at Station 12; he was killed while assisting a motorist at the scene of an accident, and in recognition 6 7 of his sacrifice, his family was presented with a posthumous Star of Texas Award from Governor Rick Perry in September 2014; and 8 WHEREAS, Scott Tanksley was born in Dallas on November 1,

9 1973, to Robert Wayne and Juanita Gayle Tanksley; he was a star 10 11 baseball player at Kemp High School, and he declined a draft offer 12 from the Baltimore Orioles in order to attend Mississippi State University, where he made the SEC Academic Honor Roll in 1995 and 13 14 served as a relief pitcher for the MSU Bulldogs baseball team; and WHEREAS, Mr. Tanksley's skill on the pitcher's mound won him 15 recognition as a Mizuno freshman All-American in 1993; he was the 16 last freshman in the school's history to throw a complete-game 17 shutout, and he continues to rank in MSU's all-time top 10 in seven 18 statistical categories; in 1995, he was drafted by the Minnesota 19

WHEREAS, In 1998, Mr. Tanksley married Wendi Prine, and they shared 16 rewarding years together; he was the devoted father of three, Laynee, Levi, and Lynlee Grace, and he delighted in the time

Twins, and he played in the team's minor league system for three
