5 independent Ys across Texas, the Texas State Alliance of YMCAs  
6 works diligently to further the mission of the YMCA, which is to  
7 build strong kids, strong families, and strong communities through  
8 programs that develop healthy spirits, minds, and bodies; and

9           WHEREAS, The alliance mobilizes staff, volunteers, and  
10 community leaders to advocate on behalf of local Ys; these  
11 institutions nurture children and promote youth development,
