1 WHEREAS, Proud citizens of Brewster County are gathering at

2 the State Capitol today to celebrate Brewster County Day; and

3 WHEREAS, Located in the Trans-Pecos region of West Texas, the

4 striking landscape of Brewster County incorporates mountains,

5 desert, grasslands, and forest, which are rich with wildlife such

6 as pronghorn antelope, white-tail deer, bighorn sheep, mountain

7 lions, black bears, and coyotes; and

8 WHEREAS, The region was first inhabited by nomadic hunters

9 9,000 years ago, and people began growing crops there 1,000 years

10 ago; the first Spanish explorers arrived in the 16th century, but

11 the rugged terrain discouraged permanent settlement until after the

12 Civil War, when the arrival of the railroad and the presence of the

13 U.S. Army and the Texas Rangers enabled the rise of cattle

14 ranching; and

WHEREAS, Established in 1887, Brewster County is the largest

16 county in Texas, nearly as large as the states of Connecticut and

17 Rhode Island put together; the discovery of mercury in 1884 touched

18 off a mining boom, and by the early 20th century, the Chisos Mining

19 Company was producing 20 percent of the mercury in the nation; and

20 WHEREAS, Today, the cattle industry, education, and tourism

21 are essential to the county's economy and culture; situated in the

22 county seat of Alpine, Sul Ross State University offers students a

23 wide range of bachelor's and master's degree programs, as well as a

24 low student-to-teacher ratio; Big Bend National Park features

- 2 up to 350,000 visitors a year, and the Terlingua International
- 3 Chili Championship, which is held every November, draws competitors
- 4 from across the state and nation; and
