1 WHEREAS, Carson Joines retired as mayor of Carthage in 2 January 2014, concluding more than four decades of outstanding 3 civic leadership, and the dedication and vision he demonstrated in 4 his work are indeed worthy of recognition; and

5 WHEREAS, This esteemed public servant was the town's mayor for 32 years, having first been elected to the post in 1982; before 6 7 that, he was a member of the city commission from 1972 to 1983 and held the post of mayor pro tempore for 10 years; during his tenure 8 9 in government, he provided strong support for city employees, helping them to better serve Carthage residents, and he furthered a 10 11 broad range of other initiatives that have greatly enhanced the 12 city; and

13 WHEREAS, Mayor Joines played a prominent role in regional 14 government and area service organizations as well; he served as president of the East Texas Council of Governments and the Carthage 15 16 Economic Development Corporation, and he was a member of the boards of the Panola County Chamber of Commerce, the Panola County 17 Economic Development Foundation, and the Texas Country Music Hall 18 of Fame; in addition, he was active in the Rotary Club and led the 19 20 organization as president; and

21 WHEREAS, A longtime Carthage citizen, Mayor Joines first 22 moved to the area in 1948 to play football at Panola Junior College, 23 helping the team win two championships, and his ties to the town 24 grew stronger after he met and married local resident Dixie Arnold;

he served his nation as a member of the United States Army during 1 the Korean War and earned his bachelor of business administration 2 3 degree from Stephen F. Austin State University before embarking on a 37-year career with Union Pacific Railroad; through the years, 4 5 his family has grown to include three children, nine grandchildren, and seven great-grandchildren, and he is looking forward to 6 7 spending additional time with his loved ones during his retirement; 8 and

9 WHEREAS, Greatly admired for his commitment to his fellow 10 citizens, Carson Joines has devoted nearly half of his life to 11 public service, and his many contributions to the City of Carthage 12 will be remembered and admired for years to come; now, therefore, be 13 it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas 15 Legislature hereby commend the Honorable Carson Joines for his many 16 years of exemplary service to his community and extend to him 17 sincere best wishes for continued happiness; and, be it further
