## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Proud residents of the Mid-Valley region of Texas
are gathering in Austin on February 11, 2015, to celebrate
Mid-Valley Day at the State Capitol; and

WHEREAS, Located in eastern Hidalgo County in the Rio Grande Valley, the Mid-Valley region includes the towns of Alamo, Donna, Mercedes, Pharr, Progreso, Progreso Lakes, San Juan, and Weslaco; this area is a center for agribusiness, with farmers producing sugarcane, grains, and citrus fruit such as grapefruits and oranges; and

WHEREAS, The city of Alamo is located in proximity to the Santa Ana National Wildlife Refuge, which encompasses more than 2,000 acres of protected land and is home to a wide array of animals and plants; in addition, the town boasts a birding information center and the popular Alamo Central Park; and

15 WHEREAS, Upholding the motto "the City with a Heart in the 16 Heart of the Rio Grande Valley," Donna serves as the location of the 17 Donna-Rio Bravo International Bridge, which helps to facilitate 18 shopping, tourism, and commercial trade to and from Mexico; and

WHEREAS, Mercedes has long been a major center for the processing and marketing of livestock, cotton, and vegetables, and it is also known for its boot makers and the shopping opportunities at the Rio Grande Valley Premium Outlets; the annual Rio Grande Valley Livestock Show and Rodeo draws more than 200,000 people to town each year, and the event provides valuable scholarship funds

1 for 4-H and FFA students; and

WHEREAS, Known as the Hub City of the Rio Grande Valley, Pharr is home to the Pharr International Bridge, which for more than two decades has served as a reliable passage for exported produce and textiles; moreover, the town has been recognized as a Triple Crown City in honor of national awards it has received for commitment to historic preservation, economic development, and civic excellence; and

9 WHEREAS, In addition to being centers for the sugarcane 10 business, Progreso and Progreso Lakes have been serving as gateways 11 to the Rio Grande Valley since the opening of the Progreso/Nuevo 12 Progreso International Bridge in 2003; and

13 WHEREAS, Fast-growing San Juan is the home of the Basilica of 14 Our Lady of San Juan del Valle National Shrine, which attracts 15 multitudes of pilgrims from throughout the United States and 16 Mexico; the town hosts an annual Spring Fiesta and is the site of 17 numerous parks, including Liberty Park, with its flagpole monument 18 honoring those who have served in the U.S. armed forces; and

WHEREAS, The city of Weslaco has become a favorite destination for tourists, golfers, retirees, and birders, and it is the location of two important Texas A&M University research stations; the annual Onion Fest celebrates the development of the famous Texas 1015 onion in Weslaco, and this popular event brings many visitors to the city; and

WHEREAS, Throughout the Mid-Valley region, great emphasis is placed on the value of education; the Science Academy of South Texas in Mercedes consistently ranks among the top 100 on *Newsweek*'s list

of "America's Best High Schools"; in addition, IDEA Public Schools, a nonprofit network of charter schools with 26 campuses in the Rio Grande Valley alone, is helping young Texans build a strong foundation for future success; 99 percent of IDEA alumni go on to enroll in a college or a university, and they graduate from those institutions at five times the national average for students of similar backgrounds; and

8 WHEREAS, The residents of this dynamic region of the Lone 9 Star State are justifiably proud of their hard work, civic 10 commitment, and innovative spirit, and their efforts have created a 11 group of notable Texas communities that are well prepared to meet 12 the challenges and opportunities of the future; now, therefore, be 13 it
