- 19 DaMarkus Lodge, who racked up 101 yards on four receptions and
- 20 accounted for both of the team's touchdowns on his way to earning
- 21 the game's Offensive Most Valuable Player award; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Focused on their slogan "Be Remembered," the
- 23 Longhorns received valuable contributions throughout the year from
- 24 each player on the roster, and together they posted a season record
