11 most recently held the titles of chief communications officer and
12 chief of special projects for Spring ISD; and

13 WHEREAS, Throughout her remarkable tenure, Ms. Boutte worked
14 diligently to foster a supportive and challenging learning
15 environment within Spring ISD schools; in the process, she earned
16 the admiration and respect of students and colleagues alike; and

17 WHEREAS, Regina Boutte has demonstrated exemplary leadership
18 and dedication during her 24 years as an educator, and her
19 contributions to Spring ISD have had a positive and lasting
20 influence on the lives of countless students; now, therefore, be it
