RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Members of the health care community are gathering 2 in Austin on February 17, 2015, in observance of Texas Trauma and 3 Emergency Health Care Day at the State Capitol; and

WHEREAS, Dedicated to the well-being of their fellow 4 5 citizens, the health care professionals of the Texas trauma system respond at a moment's notice to emergency situations, which can 6 7 range from motor vehicle accidents and natural disasters to medical 8 crises such as heart attacks and strokes; they often put their own 9 lives at risk as they react with speed, compassion, and 10 professionalism; and

11 WHEREAS, The Texas trauma system has 286 designated trauma 12 facilities, which are supported by 22 trauma service area regional 13 advisory councils; more than 62,000 EMS personnel, 40,000 nurses, 14 and 2,000 trauma and emergency physicians work with their 15 colleagues to provide lifesaving care and vital rehabilitation 16 services to the state's large and diverse population; and

WHEREAS, When urgent medical needs arise, Texans rely completely on the availability of swift assistance, and it is indeed appropriate to recognize the vital role played in our society by emergency medical personnel; now, therefore, be it
