RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Organ donations save countless lives in Texas and 2 the United States each year, but there is a critical shortage of
- 3 organs available for transplant; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Statistics demonstrate the urgent need for organ
- 5 donors, with over 110,000 individuals currently on the national
- 6 waiting list for transplants, more than 10,000 of whom reside in
- 7 Texas; a person is added to the list every 11 minutes, and each day
- 8 18 people die while waiting for organs to become available; and
- 9 WHEREAS, A single donor can save up to eight lives by giving
- 10 their heart, liver, pancreas, kidneys, lungs, and small bowels to
- 11 patients in dire need of these crucial organs; additionally, tissue
- 12 transplants from the donor can be used to treat severe burns,
- 13 injuries, and impaired vision in another 50 recipients; and
- 14 WHEREAS, In 1995, Rodney DeBaun and his wife, Isibelle,
- 15 started the David Nicklas Organ Donor Awareness Foundation; named
- 16 in honor of the young man whose heart was donated to Mr. DeBaun,
- 17 this nonprofit organization is dedicated to narrowing the gap
- 18 between transplant patients and the nearest transplant hospital;
- 19 for the first five years, the foundation achieved this mission by
- 20 maintaining two airplanes, one to fly patients and their families
- 21 to the hospital at any time of the day or night, and the other to
- 22 perform at air shows, generating money and increasing awareness of
- 23 this serious medical issue; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Wanting to permanently endow the foundation,

- 1 Mr. DeBaun built The Landings of Carrier Parkway apartment complex
- 2 in 2000; the majority of the 281 units are rented out to bring in
- 3 funds, but at least five are provided free of charge to out-of-town
- 4 transplant patients and their families; over the years, more than
- 5 30 transplant recipients have lived in the complex and benefited
- 6 from its proximity to The University of Texas Southwestern Medical
- 7 Center; and
- 8 WHEREAS, For the last two decades, the Nicklas Foundation has
- 9 worked tirelessly to help transplant patients obtain essential
- 10 medical care and to raise awareness of the lifesaving power of organ
- 11 and tissue donation, and in so doing, it has contributed
- 12 immeasurably to the health and well-being of many residents of the
- 13 Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas
- 15 Legislature hereby recognize February 24, 2015, as Donor Day at the
- 16 State Capitol and commend the David Nicklas Organ Donor Awareness
- 17 Foundation and the other individuals, organizations, and agencies
- 18 involved in this worthy endeavor; and, be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
- 20 prepared for the Nicklas Foundation as an expression of high regard
- 21 by the Texas House of Representatives.
