Texas A&M Forest Service; and

3 WHEREAS, Established by the 34th Texas Legislature in 1915, the TFS is the first state forestry agency in the nation to be part 4 5 of a land grant institution; it holds as its mission the preservation of the state's trees, forests, and related natural 6 7 resources, and it has led the way in sustainability and conservation, forestry education, and wildfire suppression; with 8 9 protection against wildfires as one of its most important goals, the agency provides grants to train and equip firefighters and 10 helps direct regional incident management teams in times of such 11 12 disasters; and

WHEREAS, The TFS is further dedicated to the beautification of the Lone Star State; its forestry research has contributed significantly to the health and productivity of our woodlands, and its field offices work with their communities to plant and care for trees; the agency also assists landowners with responsible forest management and supports the forest industry; and

WHEREAS, Beginning with the early efforts of a few forest patrolmen on horseback in East Texas a century ago, the TFS has made great strides in ensuring the safety of our citizens and property and in preserving the scenic landscape for which Texas is so justly renowned; now, therefore, be it
