1 WHEREAS, Continuing a proud tradition of success on the 2 gridiron, the Canadian High School football team captured the 3 University Interscholastic League 2A Division 1 state championship 4 on December 18, 2014, at AT&T Stadium in Arlington; and

5 WHEREAS, The Wildcats won the state title with a 34-7 triumph 6 over Mason High School, taking home the school's third state 7 championship in football and completing a season in which they 8 dominated their competition en route to an undefeated 15-0 record; 9 and

WHEREAS, After beginning its march through the postseason with an impressive victory over Windthorst, Canadian went on to defeat Stratford and Abernathy High Schools to secure a spot in the state semifinals against Mart; in that game, the Wildcats raced out to a three-touchdown lead at halftime before closing out a 49-14 win and earning a trip to the state championship game; and

WHEREAS, The 2A Division 1 finale against Mason High provided 16 an exciting matchup between two previously unbeaten squads; the 17 18 Wildcats were held scoreless in the opening quarter, as Mason jumped out to an early 7-0 lead, but Canadian responded with 34 19 unanswered points over the final three quarters to claim the 20 21 championship; quarterback Tanner Schafer was selected as the Offensive Most Valuable Player of the game, and linebacker Andrew 22 23 Ezzell was named the Defensive MVP for his 10-tackle performance; 24 and
