WHEREAS, Once students are admitted to UT-Arlington, they can count on the assistance of TRIO-Student Support Services, which since 1976 has offered free academic assistance to low-income or first-generation students; students who wish to pursue their education beyond a bachelor's degree may take advantage of the McNair Scholars Program, which helps undergraduates with the

3 WHEREAS, Taken together, these worthwhile programs have 4 helped countless young Texans to pursue the dream of a college 5 education, giving them the tools they need to achieve a prosperous, 6 productive, and fulfilling life; now, therefore, be it
