R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Members of the Texas Chiropractic Association are
2 gathering in Austin on March 4, 2015, to celebrate Texas
3 Chiropractic Association Day at the State Capitol; and

4 WHEREAS, Since the founding of chiropractic in 1895,
5 physicians trained in this discipline have provided natural and
6 conservative methods of health care without the use of surgery or
7 medication; and

8 WHEREAS, Doctors of chiropractic devote careful attention to
9 the biomechanics, structure, and function of the spine, its effects
10 on the musculoskeletal and neurological systems, and the role
11 played by the proper function of these systems in the preservation
12 and restoration of health; and

13 WHEREAS, While patients visit chiropractors for a myriad of
14 reasons, many are looking for relief from back pain; more than 31
15 million Americans suffer from this pervasive condition and one-half
16 of all working Americans admit to having this symptom, many
17 experiencing pain severe enough for them to seek professional help;

19 WHEREAS, The Texas Chiropractic Association has served the
20 interests of doctors of chiropractic and chiropractic patients
21 across Texas since 1916; the organization and its members work to
22 contain and lower health care costs while providing increased
23 access to care for millions in the Lone Star State; and

2 notable contributions to the citizens of this state are indeed
