1           WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives is pleased to  
2 recognize the pregnancy resource centers in this state, which offer  
3 counseling and other services to women facing unexpected pregnancy;  
4 and

5           WHEREAS, Pregnancy resource centers provide free or low-cost  
6 pregnancy tests and sonograms, emotional support, and education,  
7 and they work in conjunction with maternity homes and adoption  
8 centers to provide options for pregnant women; and

9           WHEREAS, Dedicated to meeting both the immediate and the  
10 long-term needs of their clients, the centers offer a variety of  
11 classes to ensure that potential mothers-to-be have important life  
12 skills that help women of all ages and backgrounds realize their  
13 full potential as mothers and as productive members of society;  
14 courses include parenting, budget keeping, and in some locations,  
15 English as a second language; and

16           WHEREAS, Pregnancy resource centers play a unique role in  
17 Texas and around the country; the centers provide a place of  
18 contemplation for women considering the possibility of motherhood  
19 and emphasize the need for education and mindful decision making;  
20 now, therefore, be it
