- 18 Francis Aviation; under his leadership, the enterprise thrived and
- 19 quickly expanded its operations to the Las Cruces International

- 22 his contributions to his community; he served on the boards of the
- 23 Doña Ana County International Jetport, the War Eagles Air Museum,

- 5 and he looked back on his climb past Advanced Base Camp on Mount
- 6 Everest as one of his most exhilarating experiences; his enthusiasm

- 8 and his warmth, kind spirit, and natural charm seldom failed to

- 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Francis devoted himself to a wide range of
- 11 pursuits, but he treasured the moments he spent with his family
- 12 above all else; on October 30, 2013, he exchanged wedding vows with
- 13 the love of his life, Sara Paben; their relationship was a source of
- 14 much happiness and fulfillment to him, and he was anticipating the
- 15 arrival of their first child, Tyler Elizabeth-Jean Francis, in
