5 WHEREAS, Born in El Paso on March 6, 1985, to Rick and Ginger 6 Francis, Tyler Francis graduated with a bachelor's degree in 7 organizational communication from The University of Texas at El 8 Paso and subsequently earned an MBA from Texas Tech University in 9 2011; and

WHEREAS, The son of a bank chairman and the grandson of a 10 former El Paso mayor, Mr. Francis surprised many when he chose to 11 pursue a career in aviation; he developed a passion for flying early 12 on, building radio-controlled airplanes at the age of 10 and 13 purchasing his first plane in graduate school; he gained invaluable 14 experience working at Blue Feather Aero, a fixed-base operator at 15 16 the Doña Ana County International Jetport in Santa Teresa, New Mexico, and he bought the company in December 2012, renaming it 17 Francis Aviation; under his leadership, the enterprise thrived and 18 quickly expanded its operations to the Las Cruces International 19 20 Airport; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Francis further distinguished himself through 22 his contributions to his community; he served on the boards of the 23 Doña Ana County International Jetport, the War Eagles Air Museum, 24 and the Amigo Airsho and on the Boy Scouts of America Yucca Council;

3 WHEREAS, Always eager for a new challenge or adventure, 4 Mr. Francis enjoyed countless hours of hiking, camping, and skiing, 5 and he looked back on his climb past Advanced Base Camp on Mount 6 Everest as one of his most exhilarating experiences; his enthusiasm 7 and positive outlook called forth the best in everyone around him, 8 and his warmth, kind spirit, and natural charm seldom failed to 9 brighten their days; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Francis devoted himself to a wide range of 11 pursuits, but he treasured the moments he spent with his family 12 above all else; on October 30, 2013, he exchanged wedding vows with 13 the love of his life, Sara Paben; their relationship was a source of 14 much happiness and fulfillment to him, and he was anticipating the 15 arrival of their first child, Tyler Elizabeth-Jean Francis, in 16 March 2015; and

WHEREAS, Although his years on this earth were far too few, the joy that Tyler Francis brought to his loved ones will never be forgotten, and the example of his life will forever inspire them to seize each day and to reach boldly for their dreams; now, therefore, be it
