R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, George Flint of Plano has been elected chair of the  
2 Collin County Republican Party, and as he continues this act of  
3 service, it is indeed fitting to recognize him for his many  
4 contributions to civic life; and

5           WHEREAS, An attorney and small-business owner, Mr. Flint has  
6 long been active in the GOP, and he has served the Collin County  
7 Republican Party as general counsel since 2009; he has given  
8 generously of his financial resources to support the party and its  
9 candidates, and he has served in such capacities as co-chair of the  
10 Bylaws and Rules Committee for the Collin County Republican Party,  
11 co-chair of the Senate District 8 Resolutions Committee, and  
12 Delegate to the Texas State Republican Convention; in addition, he  
13 was a member of the state party's Convention Rules Committee in  
14 2012, and he was an Alternate Texas Delegate to the Republican

21 practice with the Flint Firm encompasses business and contract law,  
22 mediation, and complex litigation, among other areas of expertise,  
23 and his professional affiliations include the Association of  
24 Attorney-Mediators, the American Health Lawyers Association, the

1 Christian Legal Society, and the Collin County Bar Association; and

2       WHEREAS, Deeply committed to his community, Mr. Flint is a  
3 member of Christ Church Plano, and he has provided pro bono legal  
4 services to religious institutions and nonprofit organizations; he  
5 serves as director of Real Options for Women and as a volunteer  
6 arbitrator for the Better Business Bureau of Metropolitan Dallas;

8       WHEREAS, George Flint has set an outstanding example of civic  
9 leadership, and the members of the Collin County Republican Party  
10 are fortunate indeed to have the benefit of his knowledge and
