1 WHEREAS, Young readers are gathering at Ray High School in
2 Corpus Christi on February 28, 2015, for the first annual Teen
3 Bookfest by the Bay; and

4 WHEREAS, Bringing together teenage readers with 16 popular
5 writers of young adult fiction, this free event is sponsored by the
6 Corpus Christi Public Libraries, the Nueces County Library System,
7 the Portland Public Library, and Texas A&M University-Corpus
8 Christi, as well as librarians from the Aransas County, Calallen,
9 Corpus Christi, Flour Bluff, Gregory-Portland, Orange Grove, Port
10 Aransas, Sinton, Tuloso-Midway, and West Oso Independent School
11 Districts; and

12 WHEREAS, The writers, most of whom are from Texas, include

17 Patrick), Joy Preble, Victoria Scott, Joe Shine, and Django Wexler;

19 WHEREAS, In panel discussions, the authors will talk about
20 the process of writing and publishing, as well as such topics of
21 interest as fantasy, paranormal fiction, and manga comics; there
22 will be a "Steampunk Social" during the lunch break and a flash
23 fiction session in the afternoon, and the day will conclude with the
24 authors meeting readers and signing copies of their books; and

2 young people, and this unique event offers readers in Corpus
3 Christi and the surrounding region an opportunity to learn from and
4 be inspired by a dynamic group of successful authors; now,
