1           WHEREAS, The Hesles family has an impressive history of  
2 business success in Eagle Pass; and

3           WHEREAS, In 1934, the Hesles Food Store was founded by  
4 Alfredo Napoles Hesles and his wife, Bertha; after serving his  
5 nation in World War II, Mr. Hesles returned to Eagle Pass and  
6 diversified his business holdings, purchasing the historic Lane  
7 Motel and reopening it as the Hesles Motel; and

8           WHEREAS, Alfredo and Bertha's son, Richard Hesles, and his  
9 wife, Angelica, took over the store during the 1980s, and expanded  
10 the business further to include real estate; and

11           WHEREAS, Although Richard Hesles passed away in 2010,  
12 Angelica Hesles and their children continue to run the Hesles  
13 family enterprises, including their store, now known as Hesles  
14 Sporting Goods; and

15           WHEREAS, In September 2012, this flagship business was the  
16 first to take part in the Eagle Pass Store Front Restoration  
17 Program, and Mrs. Hesles and her family are among the biggest  
18 supporters of the city's Main Street Program; and

19           WHEREAS, Family businesses are essential to the prosperity  
20 and well-being of Texas communities, and the Hesles family may  
21 indeed reflect with pride on their eight decades of serving their  
22 friends and neighbors in Eagle Pass; now, therefore, be it

23           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas  
24 Legislature hereby recognize Hesles Sporting Goods Day and extend
