10 that department, he will continue to serve area residents as chief
11 of the Pottsboro Fire Department; and

13 and support of his wife, Donna, and their three children, Daniel,
14 David, and Katie; and

15 WHEREAS, Donnie Glenn has exemplified the highest ideals of
16 his profession throughout his career, and his unwavering dedication
