R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Captain Brett Baker Flagg Jr. of Frisco has rendered
2 outstanding service to his nation as a member of the United States
3 Army; and

4 WHEREAS, A 2006 graduate of Trinity Christian Academy in
5 Addison, where he was a National Merit Finalist, this gifted young
6 man earned an appointment to the U.S. Military Academy at West
7 Point; during his time at the academy, he completed Airborne School
8 and Air Assault School and received the Superintendent's Award for
9 Achievement; he also served as an intern with the President's
10 Council of Economic Advisors; and

11 WHEREAS, Following his graduation from West Point in 2010,
12 Brett Flagg was commissioned as a second lieutenant; he served in
13 Afghanistan as a cavalry scout platoon leader from July 2012 to
14 March 2013, earning the Bronze Star, and in 2014, he was promoted to

16 WHEREAS, Captain Flagg is currently stationed at Fort Hood,
17 where he serves as squadron logistics officer with the 6th
18 Squadron, 9th U.S. Cavalry Regiment, 3rd Brigade, 1st Cavalry
19 Division; and

21 men and women who take up arms in the defense of our nation, and
22 Captain Brett Flagg has earned special distinction for his
23 patriotism, his professionalism, and his devotion to duty; now,
