1           WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the sorrow felt at  
2 the untimely death of Spencer Paul Golvach of Houston, who passed  
3 away on January 31, 2015, at the age of 25; and

4           WHEREAS, Born in Houston on September 27, 1989, Spencer  
5 Golvach was the son of Dan and Julie Golvach and enjoyed the  
6 companionship of two brothers, Christopher and Dylan; and

7           WHEREAS, Mr. Golvach was passionate about music, and he owned  
8 Spencer's Guitar Shop in Cypress, where he delighted in connecting  
9 with the music community; moreover, he found great fulfillment as  
10 bassist for the Led Zeppelin cover band Von Hindenburg and for the  
11 Dead Revolt, a progressive rock trio he formed with his brother  
12 Dylan on drums and George Baba on vocals and guitar; and

13           WHEREAS, The Dead Revolt grew out of Mr. Golvach's previous  
14 group, VOID, and they regularly performed at venues throughout  
15 Houston; over the years, the band released three full-length  
16 albums, *The Substance of Things Not Seen*, *Vanixer*, and *Psychedelic*  
17 *Wasteland*, as well as an EP, *A Night of Nostalgia*; and

18           WHEREAS, Above all else, Mr. Golvach was treasured for his  
19 kindness and his generosity; he was a mentor and role model to his  
20 younger brother, and he was always ready to offer encouragement or a  
21 helping hand to friends; in addition, he was deeply devoted to his  
22 girlfriend, Sara, and their relationship was a source of much  
23 happiness and fulfillment to him; and

24           WHEREAS, All those who were privileged to know Spencer

1 Golvach will forever find inspiration in the ways he expressed his  
2 creative gifts and in the joy and enthusiasm with which he lived;  
3 now, therefore, be it

4         RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas  
5 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Spencer Paul  
6 Golvach and extend sincere condolences to the members of his  
7 family: to his parents, Dan and Julie Golvach; to his brothers,  
8 Christopher Golvach and his wife, Jennifer Doerre, and Dylan  
9 Golvach; to his niece, Elizabeth, and his nephew, William; to his  
10 aunts and uncles, Steve, Mitch and Brenda, Jack and Shelly, Jim, Joe  
11 and Gretchen, and Nikki and Jake; to his girlfriend, Sara  
12 Whittemore; and to his many other relatives and friends; and, be it
