- 17 Wasteland, as well as an EP, A Night of Nostalgia; and
- WHEREAS, Above all else, Mr. Golvach was treasured for his
- 19 kindness and his generosity; he was a mentor and role model to his
- 20 younger brother, and he was always ready to offer encouragement or a
- 21 helping hand to friends; in addition, he was deeply devoted to his
- 22 girlfriend, Sara, and their relationship was a source of much
- 23 happiness and fulfillment to him; and
