21           WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Kerekgyarto's dedication to excellence  
22 and his perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him  
23 worthy to stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect  
24 with pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it
