- 2 dependents of military service members, according to the Military
- 3 Brats Registry; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The children of military personnel make significant
- 5 sacrifices; they grow up without the advantages of a hometown
- 6 atmosphere, and most of them attend between 7 and 12 different
- 7 schools before graduating from high school; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Through their upbringing, the children of military
- 9 personnel gain a unique appreciation for the duties and
- 10 responsibilities of members of the United States armed forces; the
- 11 word "brat" may be pejorative in some contexts, but those who answer
- 12 questions about their childhood with the explanation "I'm a
- 13 military brat" take pride in the service of their parents and in the
- 14 support and encouragement military families provide to the brave
- 15 men and women who protect our freedom; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Military Brat pins have been created to recognize
- 17 the experiences of the children of veterans, and the production of
- 18 such pins is indeed a commendable effort; now, therefore, be it
- 19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 84th Texas
- 20 Legislature hereby express support for Military Brat pins honoring
- 21 those who grew up as dependents of military personnel.
