R E S O L U T I O N

1        WHEREAS, Cynthia M. Sakulenzki of McAllen celebrated her 15th  
2 anniversary as president and CEO of the Rio Grande Valley Hispanic  
3 Chamber of Commerce in February 2015, and the attainment of this  
4 special milestone offers a fitting opportunity to recognize this

23 Bronc Athletic Fund, and El Milagro Clinic, all of which she has  
24 served as a board member; and

2 and support of her children, David, Jonathan, and Jeremy, and her  
3 granddaughter, McKenzie; her favorite leisure pastimes include  
4 traveling, fishing, and watching a variety of sports, including

6 entertaining family and friends; and
